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How People can Overcome the Judgment at Armageddon

This Document's original draft is a few years old, but it is still significant. Please also see the bottom of Document # 18.

In the N.I.V., Romans 13 verse 8 states "Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for he who loves his fellowman has fulfilled the law." Besides the 10 Commandments, this also means that love fulfills all religions and bibles. Therefore, when Jesus climbed his mountain (Sermon on the Mount/Zion; Matt. 5 & Hew. 12: 18-22), he was explaining how he would, and how others would also fulfill the Laws of Moses. For example, in Matt. 5: 38, Jesus quoted the Old Testament law, mediated by Moses in Exodus 21: 24 that states, "Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth." He then explained that through love, this philosophy would be overridden and fulfilled. Jesus stated, "Do not resist an evil person. If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also." If Jesus had chosen to act according to Moses' way (eye for an eye), he would not be acting in love, and therefore, would not have fulfilled that particular law. This is the same for all believers of Jesus. A believer is one who is a doer of the words of Jesus. In another example, using the "The Living Bible" version, Jesus said, "Under the laws of Moses the rule was, 'If you Murder you must die.' But I have added to that rule, and tell you that if you are only angry, even in your own home, you are in danger of Judgment!" Murder is unlawful, and you will be condemned for it, but in order to stop the act, or shall we say the fruit of killing, one must stop it from germinating in ones own mind. Anger precedes murder, and if you let that anger grow within, it's only a matter of time before it becomes a full blown act of violence, which could result in murder; this would take some denying of oneself which is essential for fulfilling the laws through love.

Moreover, Jesus on his mountain went on to *enhance* many other old *ways* of the Kindergarten Era (Gal. 4: 1-11), so that humanity could graduate to the 3rd Person of the Godhead and enter the Spirit Era. In this Spirit Era the language is different in a way that metaphors, allegories and irony best explain it. That's why Jesus spoke figuratively and in parables. Only when one chooses to *do* as Jesus' *did* will one receive this Third Person within, which will enable them to discern spiritual things. (St. John 14: 15- 21 & 2 Cor. 2: 10- 16) Furthermore, besides enhancing the laws from his mountain, Jesus displayed what God wanted throughout his ministry and life. One such example occurred when they arrested him and one individual used his sword to get Jesus out of that bad situation, in Matthew 26: 52 Jesus said, "Put your sword back in its place," Jesus said to him, "for all who draw the sword will die by the sword...." Some have tried to negate this verse by stating that Jesus told the Apostles to buy swords in Luke 22: 36- 38. But this is because Jesus saw that they were rejecting his message of non-violence and he was explaining to his Apostles that he foresaw a future with violence, symbolized by the sword; for in verse 38 of the same chapter, the Apostles brought him two swords and he was not pleased, and then told them that, that was enough.

True believers of Jesus know what Jesus stood and still stands for. The 3rd Person of the Godhead teaches that the use of the sword belongs to the "Eye for and eye and a tooth for tooth" era; a behavior that belongs to

Mount Sinai and Moses' Era, and therefore, does not fulfill Jesus' ways, and is certainly not an act of love. Those who follow Moses' system are slaves and will have the spirit to persecute others. (Gal. 4: 24-29)

In contrast, Christendom has not always seen it in this way. Many do believe and teach that Jesus did fulfill the Law, but by this they mean that the Laws of Moses are still binding. For example, many confess to believe in Jesus' statement to turn the other cheek, but in the same sentence they confess that they believe in "Eye for an eye and a tooth for tooth." Christianity has failed to see that in his life, Jesus, specifically on the Sermon on the Mount, was contrasting his teachings with Moses' teachings. The Law came through Moses, but grace came through Jesus Christ. (St. John 1: 17) One is old and *obsolete*; the latter is new and *endless*. (Hew. 8: 13/2 Corinthians 3: 3- 18/Romans 10: 4 & Galatians 3: 25) Also, Christians have failed to see that these are two mountains, Sinai and Zion, which represent two distinct dispensations. This causes double mindedness, double standards and divisions. This has lead America and the world to the apparent division in its politics. This has gathered the world to the place that in Hebrew is called "Armageddon".

Before we continue speaking about the world being gathered at "Armageddon", we would like to recapitulate some past statements in past documents on the end times. First, in Document # 18 we elaborated on the 5th Bowl and stated:

[Since the United States is the throne of the beast; "darkness" did fall in the form of a *blackout* in the Northeast of the U.S.. Also, in Europe, specifically in England which supports the U.S., there was also a blackout within a month or two."]

Second, also in Document #18, we wrote on the 6th Bowl and stated:

[2) The 6th Bowl: - A): The Kings of the East or hurricanes happened in 2004. Hurricanes are so powerful they can go wherever they want, such as a King does. Hurricanes also suck up water, and would dry up all water if they were more powerful. Also, they cause the coast to pull back and dry up briefly. They came in the Atlantic and Pacific as never before. Florida was hit by 5 named storms and Japan was hit by 11. On Dec. 26, 2004 the last King came as a tsunami in the Indian Ocean. That one really dried up the great river Euphrates. (Rev. 16: 12) Remember, John the Revelator didn't know of great oceans because his world believed in a flat earth. $-\mathbf{B}$) The three evil spirits that keep popping up are Islam (666/Usama or False Prophet- see Photo 1), Christianity (President Bush is the Mouth of the Beast- see Photo 3 & 4) and Judaism (the Dragon, which deals with fire such as the Jewish 7 Headed Golden Candle Stick- see Photo 3). These three are the trouble makers and are always at war with each other. (Rev. 16: 13, 14) - C) Armageddon is what we stated in our documents. They are two Mountains or two ideologies/dispensations that clash with each other. One ideology believes that the sword will make the earth a better and safer place, and the other ideology does not. Pope John Paul was against the War on Terrorism; therefore, he is not the (Antichrist or correctly spelled: Anti-Christ) as many believe. (See the TIME article in our Miscellaneous Folder in CD 2 or at Greatest1command.com) We point this out, because Revelation 13: 10 specifies that the end will come through people who are pro-Sword such as President Bush and Usama Bin Laden (Rev 16: 16) Please see our documents: "Battle of the Heart pg. 1-3." Note: Revelation never uses the word: Antichrist. That word comes from 1 John 2: 18 & 4: 3.]

Furthermore, part C of the previous paragraph is of primary concern right now, for we believe it is the 3rd Phase of the 6th Bowl, which we are alluding to in this essay and the phase that the world is now entering. In the beginning of the third page of Doc. #22 we also wrote similar to part C of the last paragraph when we stated the following:

[This is Bush's patriotic/sword stance in his quest to defeat evil and create a safer world, or shall we say, create a form of heaven on earth.]

Are we all going to wake up in bed one day and say, "WOW! there is no more mention of terrorism in our world today because it was defeated?" Why was Jesus so passive; why did he not look into the future and follow President Bush's stance with the sword, in which case Jesus might have defeated evil long ago?" – Did not God say on the Mount of Transfiguration, "Listen to Jesus?" instead of the representative of the Law:

Moses or the representative of the Prophets: Elijah? (Matt. 17: 1-5) Did not Jesus clearly state in Matt. 26: 52 "for all who draw the sword will die by the sword…"? This is specifically why John the Revelator was told to write in chapter 13: 10, so that it would coincide with the 42 months that the Mouth of the Beast: President Bush was to be on earth, for the sword is his solution to the world's problems.

In addition, we also wrote in Doc, #22:

It does not matter if one is a Democrat or Republican. The group for Moses' Mountain are really Christians by name, but Jewish by form of worship. As the New International Version describes it, the three demon spirits go out to the kings of the world to gather them to battle. We believe it will begin as a spiritual battle first, which could eventually lead to a physical war among the nations. This would constitute phase three of the 6th bowl. It also states there will be a place wherein the kings are to be taken. Well, we have already stated that the place is two mountains, Jesus' and Moses'. But how can one be at either one, unless one was in the Middle East. Our rationale is as follows: In the New International Version verse 14 of the 6th Bowl states, "...for battle on the great day of God Almighty", but the "Living Bible" translates it as, "...for battle against the Lord on that great coming Judgment Day of God Almighty". Thus, the great day of God is the "Judgment". Hebrew 1: 1 states that God spoke to us in the past through the Prophets, especially through Moses, but now he speaks to us through Jesus Christ. And Hebrews 3: 3 adds that Jesus is superior to Moses. This would mean that Jesus' mountain is superior to Moses' mountain/Sinai. So then, when you choose to love as Jesus did, when you choose non-violence without the sword, and when you choose to care for your community and your environment, you have chosen Jesus' mountain/Zion. You, therefore, have come into "Judgment". Coincidentally, the "place" that Armageddon alludes to is in a valley of two mounts, or shall we say ironically, between two breasts, as in the way one's heart is placed in the middle of the human body. Therefore, Armageddon is mainly a spiritual struggle within the *heart*, which will evolve into a reformative battle between the Institution of Pastors and Priest with their bibliolatry on one side, and those who are strictly Spirit led on the other.]

In conclusion, when does one come into Judgment? Is it at Moses' Mountain/Mt. Sinai when one breaks, for example, the law not to Murder? We say no. It is at Jesus' Mountain, Mount Zion. Therefore, as Jesus stated that one would be in danger of judgment by just being *angry*, one can only conclude that "The Interpreter's Bible" is correct when its interpretation chooses and states that Armageddon will proceed from Mount Zion or simply the Sermon on the Mount: Greek; Har Migdo: God's fruitful Mountain, rather than from Mount Sinai: Greek; Har Moed: Mount of Assembly. Only unspiritual people see "Armageddon" as a physical war. Please read Document #3 "An Invitation... to the Most Misunderstood Battle"; here is a direct link:
