I'm going to share a message with everyone. Please pay attention, for it will be very radical for some, but very heretical for others...at first.

Which is the Greatest 1 command:

- 3.) To love God with all ones heart, mind and soul (Deut. 6: 5)
- **2.)** Love your neighbor as yourself. (Lev.19:18)
- **1.)** "A new command I give, love each other *as I have* loved you. In this way men will know you are My Disciples." (St. John 13:34, 35)

The True Greatest 1 Command is:

"A New command I give, love each other AS I HAVE loved you. In this way, men will know that you are my Disciples." (St. John 13:34, 35)

2) <u>A Quick Synopsis</u>: A) the religious teacher who asked which is the greatest 1 commandment in the Old Testament, was told by Jesus that he was not FAR when he accepted his 2nd additional incomplete commandment; and he also had No Salvation! He loved God in an Impersonal Way.(Mark 12:28-34) B) In contrast, the non- religious tax collector, who came down the fig tree, repented and displayed Jesus' New-complete greatest 1 command; he was elected and given Salvation! He loved People and God felt loved. (Luke 19:1-9) (Matt. 25:40) C) the Year of Jubilee is an event when all bills and deficits are *deleted* and everyone is debt free. Jesus began his ministry announcing it and the tax collector initiated it, but the religious teacher was concerned with theological arguments and rituals. (Lev. 25:10, 13) (Luke. 4: 18, 19)

Actually, Jesus was not telling the religious teacher that the commandment (to love God first of all /Deut.6:5) is the greatest in the Old Testament, but that it is *non-exclusive*; therefore, Jesus rendered it *non-greatest*. (Matt. 22:39) A true Greatest would not be comparable to any thing else; as is Jesus' exclusive 1. In referring to Jesus' Greatest, St. Paul said it correctly when he stated, the greatest is *love*."(1st Cor. 13: 13)

For 1,900 years Jesus' Greatest 1/ (St. John 13: 34), has been mistaken to be Moses' 2/ (Deut.6: 5) (Lev.19: 18) by the Antichrist/Beast/Matrix, but now the Greatest "MISTAKE" is also revealed. (2Thess. 2: 7, 8)

I Love Christianity, and I am a part of it, but we've been wrong for 1,900 years. Christianity needs to learn to be Truly Christian. And that time has come, for the Kingdom of Heaven...on Earth, is upon us!

(St. John 13: 34 & 15: 12) Before Christ, God was abstract, but now God is TRULY HUMAN and we reach him through people, like Jesus said, "When I was hungry you gave me something to eat, when I was naked you clothed me, and when I was thirsty you gave me something to drink...if you do it unto them you've done it unto me." (Matt. 25: 31-46) The Sin of Omission, or simply, *negligence*, will keep many out of the Kingdom of Heaven for the great question will be; what did you <u>do</u> to make Heaven on Earth?

God is a reflection of one's self. If one sees God as human, humble, and literally down to earth, that person will learn to be humane to others. And if one's God is not seen as human, that individual will tend to be just as inhuman as his God seems to be.

3 Evil Spirits that looked like Frogs

Judaism, Christianity and Islam are the three evil spirits that St. John saw appear, after the Kings of the East (Hurricanes) were finished. (Revelation 16: 13) All three evil spirits have a similar rhetoric that comes out of the mouth of the dragon (Judaism) – represented by the Law of Moses, the mouth of the beast (Christianity) – represented by Bush, and the mouth of the false prophet (Islam) – represented by Osama Bin Laden. Throughout history and till this day, these three religions with their Law based ideology, leap up into a violent dominance, with one at one point in time dominating or warring the other two.

So then, when you choose to love as Jesus did, when you choose for non-violence without the sword, and when you choose to care for your community and your environment, you have chosen Jesus' Mountain. You therefore have come into "judgment". The *place* that Armageddon alludes to is in a *valley* of two mounts, or shall we say ironically, between two breasts as in the way one's *heart* is placed in the *middle* of the human body.

Evermore, we would like to disclose some verses and some historical facts that led us to this conclusion, that the Man of Lawlessness is the Institution of Pastors and Priests.

The Sheep receive *justification* because they did "good deeds" towards their fellowman when they feed, invited strangers, clothed and visited the sick. But the Goats, like the Sheep, also called Jesus "Lord", but had *no* "good deeds"; they went away to eternal death. In addition, in the NIV Jesus' exhorting letters to five out of the seven churches, in the letter of Revelation, basically begin with reference to Jesus knowing their deeds. Revelation chapter 2: 2 states, "I know your *deeds*, your hard work and your perseverance..." 19) "I know your *deeds*, your love and faith, your service

and perseverance, and that you are now *doing* more than you did at first." Chapter 3 verse 1 states, "I know your *deeds*; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead...." 8) "I know your *deeds*." And verse 15) "I know your *deeds*, that you are neither cold nor hot." In addition, Revelation chapter 20 verses 12 and 13 clearly states, 12) "...The dead were judged according to what they had *done* as recorded in the books." 13) "...and each person was judged according to what he had *done*." The Apostle Paul also writes of the judgment, in Romans 2: 5 & 6, "...5) when his righteous judgment will be revealed. 6) God "will give to each person according to what he has *done*." Finally, Philippians 2: 12 states, "...continue to *work* out your salvation with fear and trembling...." So you see, its all about *doing*! The word *faith* was not mentioned, because it is a given when there is a presence of "good deeds."

If God had a name what would it be and would you call it to his face if you were faced with all his glory.... These are part of the lyrics to Joan Osborne's song, "What If God as one of us". In response to her lyrics we would definitely say "Yes". First, God is one of us. It states in Matthew 1: 23, "The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel"—which means, "God with us." This is what is traditionally called the Incarnation of God. Second, we would call it to his face for Rev. 22: 4 states that he has a face, it says, "They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads." Third, the reason we can say it to his face is because we would be his *friend*, the same name we will symbolically have on our foreheads, for as it states in St. John 15: 14 and 15...

In this stage of our spiritual growth we have come to believe that the Gospel is three-fold; first, Jesus' Incarnation is the essence of the Good News or Gospel. Second, we believe that the *essential* message of the Gospel is, in Jesus' words: "A new command I give you, love each other, as I have, loved you" from St. John 13: 34. And third, we concluded that the *fulfillment* of the Gospel is *heaven on earth* which is really, really Good News, for it is fulfilled through love in *action*, commencing at Jesus' Year of Jubilee as stated in St. Luke chapter 4 verses 18 and 19.
